Program:

- ✓ This is a grant program for people cooking and selling food from their homes.
- ✓ Limited to San Francisco residents and nearby areas (South San Francisco and Daly City)
- ✓ A one-time \$1,500 grant. You do not need to repay this.

How to Apply:

- ✧ Go to www.seaccusa.org and go to:
- ✧ Read the instructions and click on the link for the application
- ✧ This will take you to a one-page list of questions. Answer all questions and press submit. Make sure you answer all questions accurately.
- ✧ Grant application decisions will be based on your answers to these questions. If we select you, you will also need to provide a copy of your license to do a home-based food business, a copy of your personal ID, and have an interview with our staff on the phone or in person. Once these are complete and satisfactory, we will make the final grant decisions.

Basic Questions You Will Need to Answer:

- Name, address, phone number, e-mail address
- Sales in 2020
- Number of employees (not including you)
- Business permit
- Your family income
- The number of people in your family living at your residence
- Age, gender
- Experience in this business and previous food businesses
- Education level
- Who you sell to and how you do marketing?
- What kind of food do you make?
- Why you can be successful in this business?
